7:00 pm, Candles and Communion

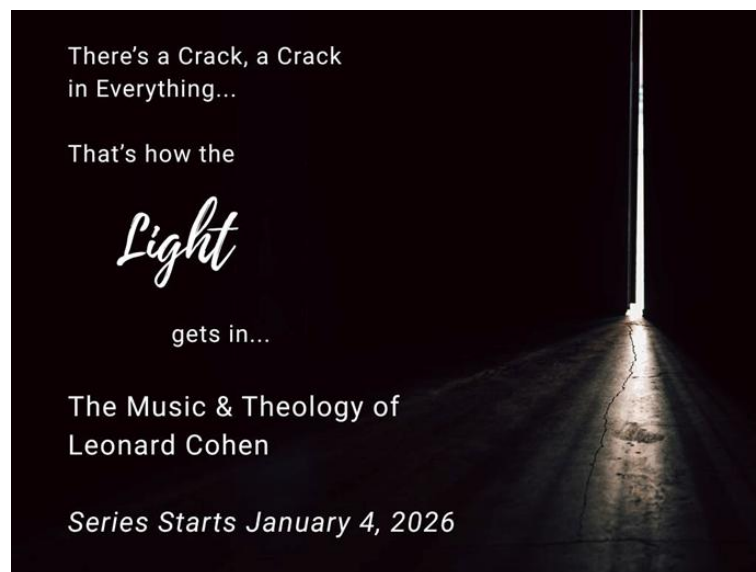
